

COMICS TEACHERS NEEDED

- B.A. or master degree in **illustration, or animation** (or equivalent degree or working experiences)
- Minimum 3 years of experiences in teaching comics to students age 6 through 16 (class size minimum 3, maximum 10).
- Skillful in comic-making supplies and techniques – including ink pen, professional markers, drawing pad, tone paper and all comic-making techniques.
- Being able to teach **comics software** a big plus (we have computers that teachers can teach)
- Must be able to design projects for teaching **caricature design, story-board, comics strips or a full page of comics** (one to three pages)
- Experienced in hosting birthday party at professional sites a big plus!
- Must be willing to help marketing, administration work, selling art supplies or products online or in-store, clean up classroom, and vacuum.
- Must work the following hours (class might be 1.5-hour or 2-hour per class meeting; teachers must be willing to switch work schedule based on demand of our class):
