

WATERCOLOR TEACHER QUALIFICATIONS

- Minimum 3-years of experiences in teaching watercolor
- B.A. or master degree in ***fine art or illustration*** (or equivalent degree or working experiences)
- Applicants with experiences in hosting birthday party at professional sites get early interview.
- Must master ***realistic watercolor painting skills and wet painting techniques*** on a variety of subjects – including animals, portraitures, landscape, plants, cityscape and still-life.
- Master in children’s books and illustration a big plus! Skillful in a variety of media (oil/acrylic paints, pastels, watercolor pencils, etc) and school of art (such as surrealism, impressionism, abstraction, etc.) a plus but not necessary.
- Must be able to design watercolor projects for students ***age 4 through 15*** (most of our students are among age 5 through 12; we might be able to open watercolor class for older age group, but it’s easier to get enrollment if you design curriculum for our current students’ age).
- Must be able to teach students age 4 – 15 independently. Must clean up the classroom.
- Must work the following hours to begin with and cover sessions in which our current watercolor teachers cannot teach (schedule might be subject to change pending on demand):

Year-round (1/1 – 3/28, 4/9 or 4/17 – 6/6 or 6/14, 8/21 or 8/28 – 12/31)	A few classes during after school hours on any weekdays on which classrooms are available (afterschool hours: <i>M, W 1pm – 9pm, Tu 3pm – 9pm, Th 2pm – 9pm, F 3:30pm – 7:30pm</i>) Sunday after 3pm (birthday party pending on request)
Spring camp (3/29 – 4/9 or 4/16 pending on demand)	W 3:30p – 5:30pm or 4 – 6pm/ 6pm – 8pm or similar hours on other weekdays M – F 12:30pm – 3:30pm
Summer camp (6/7 or 6/14 – 8/20 or 8/27 pending on demand)	Sunday 10am – 12pm / 1 – 3pm (3:30 – 6:30pm for birthday party pending on request)
<i>Must be willing to work on major holidays</i> (except 11/25 and 12/24). The schedule above might be subject to change based on demand of our class.	

- Must be willing to help marketing, administration work, selling art supplies or products online or in-store, clean up classroom, and vacuum.
- Able to host birthday party with painting themes for age 4 through adults on weekends, mostly Sundays (party of 15 people and more)
